- 5. "Despite the pervasive decay, death, and pessimism, "Ode to the West Wind" ends with a note of hope." Do you agree? Support your answer with quotations from the poem.
- 6. How does William Blake bring out the horrible conditions children were forced to work during his period? Support your answer with quotations from the poems of Blake you have studied.
