$$(i) \lim_{x \rightarrow 5} \frac{x^2 - 25}{x - 5}$$

$$(iii) \lim_{x \rightarrow \alpha} \frac{7 - 3x^2}{4x^2 + 3x - 2}$$

B. Prove the following

$$(i) \frac{1 + \sin x}{\cos x} + \frac{\cos x}{1 + \sin x} = 2 \sec x$$

$$(ii) \frac{\cot x + \operatorname{cosec} y}{\tan y + \tan x \sec y} = \cot x \cdot \cot y$$

$$(iii) y = e^{(x^2 + 1)}$$
