Punctuality means “ON TIME”

School starts at 8.30am

Students must be on site by the time the first bell rings at 8.25am – The day starts at 8.30am
Students are expected to be in their form room or assembly by 8.30am – If not they are late.

From Tuesday 31st October the student entrance gates at Limewood Road and Avenue Road will be locked at 8.25am on the first bell. Assemblies and form time provide vital information and are key for students to be successful learners and role models in the community. Examination and other learning intervention sessions start at 8.30am.

We need to teach our children that if they are late for a train, bus or plane it won't wait for them, the doors and gates will close and they will not get to their destination. Their destination at school is successful learners with the highest possible outcomes they can achieve.

End of the school day

We encourage all our students to be involved in extra curricular activities. A small minority of students however continue to inform to their parents/carers that they are in school clubs and activities when in reality they are hanging around the school site, on Northumberland Heath or simply not going home.

Parents/carers must ask themselves **DO YOU KNOW WHERE YOUR CHILD IS AND WHAT THEY ARE DOING AFTER SCHOOL?** Those attending clubs and activities can have their contact books signed to show attendance.

The school expects all students to be off the school site by 3.20pm if not attending an after school activity and the Heath by 3.30pm and on their way home. **The bus stop outside the Royal Oak pub is out of bounds**

students taking the 229 to Erith should be on the school bus that stops outside the school at 3.05pm. Erith School students are not expected to be in larger groups of more than 5 when on their way home and follow all the ERITH WAY Community Expectations.

The senior leadership team will be monitoring closely the punctuality at the start of the day and will contact parents of those children who on a regular basis are choosing not to go home at the end of the day. This is a clear safeguarding issue. Erith School works extremely hard to ensure all our students are safe inside and outside of school.
